8. Bimini top (sailboats have dodgers/powerboats have canvas covers for bridge dash,etc.) _____
9. Dock Lines (attached) Bow line, Stern line, two spring lines _____
10. Fenders (3) for most boats (4 for some powerboats or larger boats) _____
11. Miscellaneous lines including 150' blue/yellow line (for tying to shore,etc.) _____
12. Shore Power Cord /pigtail adapter _____
13. Plow,Bruce or CQR primary anchor with 200' rode _____
14. Danforth secondary anchor with 150' rode _____
15. Boat hook _____
16. Deck scrub brush/mop/pail _____
17. BBQ (mounted on rail) ***make sure you have the BBQ regulator knob** (ask CYC staff if not found) _____
18. Life ring with floating line _____
19. Heaving line (in a bag on rail) _____
20. Extra engine oil (1 litre 15W40) _____
21. Swim ladder (attached) _____
22. Instruments: GPS Chartplotter _____ Other: _____
23. VHF Radio (near chart table and sometimes in cockpit) _____
24. Inflatable Dinghy with 35'-50' floating line to tow _____
25. Oars (2) (often stored in locker on main boat) _____
26. Air pump, bailer and seat (for dinghy) _____
27. Outboard Motor (2.2 – 4hp) Usually mounted on stern rail _____
28. Outboard Fuel (in red gas can tied in dinghy) Note: some outboards have pre-mixed fuel (100:1) whereas the 4 stroke engines have straight gas _____
29. Fresh Water Tanks filled up _____
30. Diesel Fuel Tank(s) filled up _____
31. Holding Tank (s) pumped out _____
32. Propane for stove (or alcohol for some) _____
